Shikine jima

At the end of a long flight of stairs lies the hidden hot spring, Jinata Onsen. It is an iron sulfide spring with reddish-brown water. Locally, it is known as the "internal medicine bath," reputed to help with digestive disorders, neuralgia, rheumatism, poor circulation, and women's health issues. The hot spring is formed by natural rocks along the sea, so the temperature changes with the tides. Exploring the various pools and finding the perfect spot adds to the charm of the experience.

The hot spring water, flowing from 1,500 meters underground, is highly alkaline and wonderful for smooth, beautiful skin. You might even spot nocturnal animals if you look into the trees!

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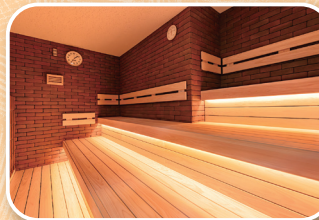

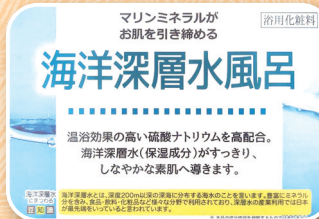
Renovated in April 2025!

This fun and unique bathhouse inspired by Greece and pro wrestling is just a 126-second walk from Tokyo Skytree Station. You can enjoy over 100 varieties of unique medicinal baths that change daily, including the signature Tower Bath, sparkling wine bath, and more! Saunas are available for both men and women, with automatic Löyly featured in the men's bath.

Komae City

TRUFFLE DONUT

At this popular shop that always has a line, you can enjoy around 10 varieties of original fresh donuts, including seasonal specials!

This long-established public bathhouse was founded in 1955 and renovated as a modern healing space. The bath uses natural water taken from the depths of the Tama River, which is then heated. The water is known to be gentle on the skin and soothing for the soul. After your bath, head to the café bar to enjoy carefully selected craft beers from across Japan. This is a new relaxation spot that goes beyond the traditional bathhouse, offering an experience for all five senses.

Akishima City



Tokyo Zoological Park Society

The park located in the Tama Hills is home to approximately 260 species of animals, where much of the lush natural environment remains.

AkishimaFujimiyu

Offering high-quality bathwater sourced from 100% well water, featuring over seven types of tubs, and including open-air bath and sauna (for an additional charge) to provide a complete "totonoi" relaxation experience. Open 22 hours a day, this iconic sento in Akishima lets you drop by freely, day or night.

Kozu shima



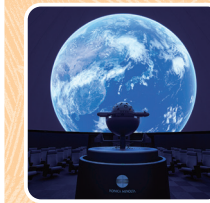
Akasaki walking path

This scenic walking path offers stunning views of Mt. Fuji and the Izu Islands. In summer, it becomes a favorite spot for children and tourists playing in the sea by jumping from the diving platform.*Please note the area will be closed for construction from late October to late December 2025.

Kozu shima hotspring recreation center

Discover one of Japan's few large open-air baths, crafted from natural rock formations! Spanning 275 square meters, the expansive space offers a breathtaking open view, perfect for melting away stress. At night, you can gaze up at a sky full of stars and immerse yourself in nature's own planetarium.

Cosmo Planetarium Shibuya

Just a 5-minute walk from Shibuya Station, this planetarium offers a wide variety of projection programs. A top recommendation is the program "Tonight" s Star Tour," where you can enjoy constellation explanations by unique and engaging guides!

Kairyoyu

At this sento, you can fully enjoy the original charm of public baths, along with beauty, health, and human connection. Refreshing your body and mind at a sento can be a nice alternative to waiting at a cafe or bookstore if you want to make the most of your time before meeting someone.

Nakano Ward



Tetsugakudo Park

This park, founded by Inoue Enryō, the founder of Toyo University and a renowned philosopher, was designed as a place for spiritual development. It visually represents the world of philosophy and serves as a distinctive venue for philosophical and social education, making it a unique park unlike any other in Japan.

Egotayu

This sento was reborn through renovation into a space reminiscent of a sacred spring inside a cave. Featuring a carbonated bath, sauna, and cold bath, this underground oasis offers a relaxing retreat where you can feel connected to the earth.

Okutama



Hikawa International Fishing Spot

This fishing spot is conveniently located just a 5-minute walk from Okutama Station. It's known for being close, spacious, and safe, so everyone from children to the elderly can enjoy fishing with peace of mind.

Moegi-no-Yu

This 100% natural hot spring draws water from deep beneath Okutama, originating from the Paleozoic strata, which is said to be Japan's oldest geological layer. Nearby, you'll find the Hikawa International Fishing Spot and Hikawa Camp Site. It's an ideal place to relax after a day of hiking or sightseeing.

Inagi City



BBQ&DINER! JU-JU

A barbecue area with a calm, relaxing atmosphere, nestled among trees in a quiet corner of a bustling amusement park.

Kakeinoyu

The open-air bath with a breathtaking view offers a spectacular panoramic view of greenery at an elevation of about 100 meters and sweeping sights of the city skyline. In the spacious area inspired by the Korean-style sauna "Purugama," you can enjoy a bedrock bath filled with negative ions. Come experience the ultimate relaxation unique to Kakeinoyu.

Oshima



OSHIMA PARK ZOO

This zoo features exhibits that make the most of the natural landscape, including mountains formed by lava from past eruptions and native forests.

Oshima Hot Spa Hotel

From the open-air bath, you can enjoy an unobstructed view of the majestic Mt. Mihara beyond the pristine forest. After you bathe, indulge in the specialty "Tsubaki Fondue," featuring local vegetables like the renowned Ashitaba and fresh seafood, lightly battered and fried in premium camellia oil.

Rooftop Kamataen

This small amusement park is located on the rooftop of Tokyo Plaza Kamata. The Ferris wheel, in particular, is beloved as the "Happy Ferris Wheel."

Enjoy a hot spring bath while watching fish! Beneath the backdrop painting of Mount Fuji is an aquarium where you can gaze at swimming goldfish and koi while soaking in the black water.

Natural Onsen Hisamatsuyu

The hot spring, drawn from 1,500 meters underground, offers a soothing and relaxing experience in the heart of Sakuradai. Projection mapping adds a stunning light display, creating the perfect setting for quality time together.



Tachikawa City



SHOWA KINEN PARK

A national park spanning Tachikawa and Akishima in Tokyo. The 2025 Koyo Autumn Leaves Festival and Autumn Night Walk is being held until Sunday, November 30. Illuminations run from 16:30 to 20:30 (park closes at 21:00). Even after the event ends, autumn foliage can still be enjoyed throughout the park until early December.

Galera Sauna Tachikawa

Located in the heart of the city, this authentic Finnish-style sauna offers a "totonoi" experience in harmony with nature. The facility requires swimwear and features separate areas for men and women, as well as a private "Premium Area" where families and friends can enjoy the sauna together, regardless of gender.

Hachioji City



TAKAO SUMIRE AN

This Japanese-style café is located at the foot of Mount Takao, right in front of Kiyotaki Station, where the cable car departs and arrives. It offers original inarizushi, grilled mochi rice cakes, and soft-serve ice cream made with local milk.

TAKAO 36 SAUNA

Enjoy moments of relaxation at the brewery and sauna located near the foot of Mount Takao after a day's outing. At this Michelin three-star destination, you can enjoy craft beer and sauna while taking in the scents of the changing seasons and colors of the sky.

Chofu City



Jindaiji Temple

This is one of the oldest temples in the Kanto region, blessed with lush greenery and spring water. It houses valuable cultural treasures, including the Shaka Nyorai statue, a national treasure.

Jindaiji natural onsen Yumorinosato

This hot spring uses spring water without any added water. Because its salt concentration is almost the same as that of the human body, it is gentle and ideal for therapeutic bathing. A bath featuring projection mapping is also available. Come visit for a relaxing time.

Chanko kirishima

The authentic chanko hot pot, passed down from the Michinoku sumo training stable, features pork bone and chicken broth, thoroughly simmered for rich flavor. After extensive refinement, it has been perfected into a light, refreshing taste.

Ryogoku Yuya Edoyu

The striking white noren curtain marks the entrance to the all-new Edo-Yu. Warm up in the bedrock bath, sauna, or large bath with walls adorned with the work of ukiyo-e artist Hokusai, a local of the area. You can also drift into a nap in the relaxation lounge or during an esthetic treatment. Let your body and mind gently unwind and enjoy a moment of pure comfort.
